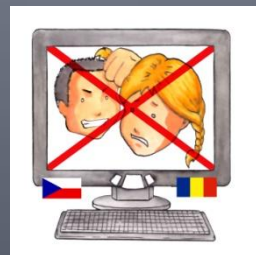
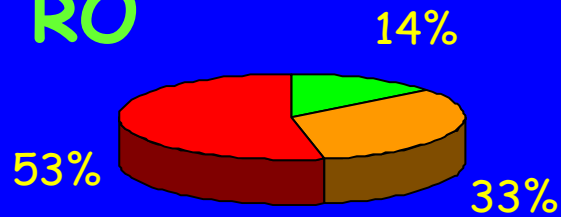

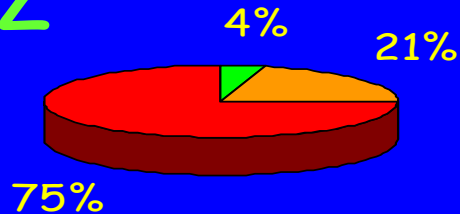
1. How often do you go on-line/use the computer?

It seems that the use of the ICT by Czech kids is more frequent than in Romania. Access to the internet is more open in the Czech Republic and more frequently used.

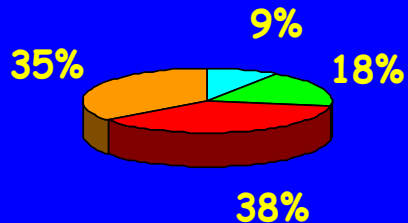

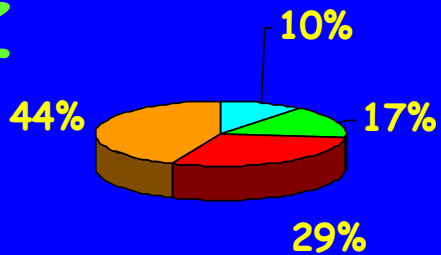
2. Daily use of computer

12. Have you deliberately left someone out of activities, spread nasty rumours, deliberately fallen out with someone for no reason in the past 6 months?



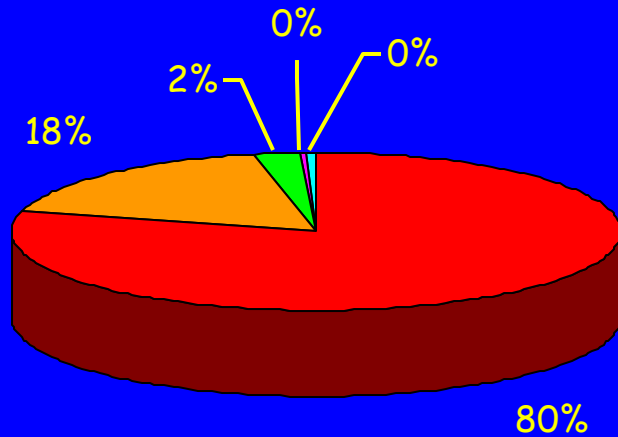

13. Have you used any of the following to threaten or embarrass someone in the previous 6 months?

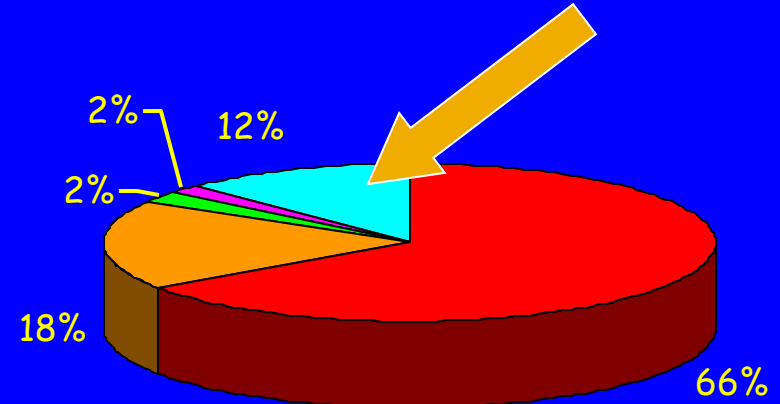

14. How frequently do you do this?



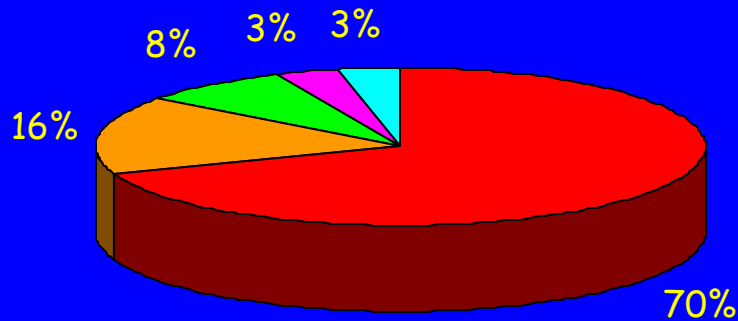

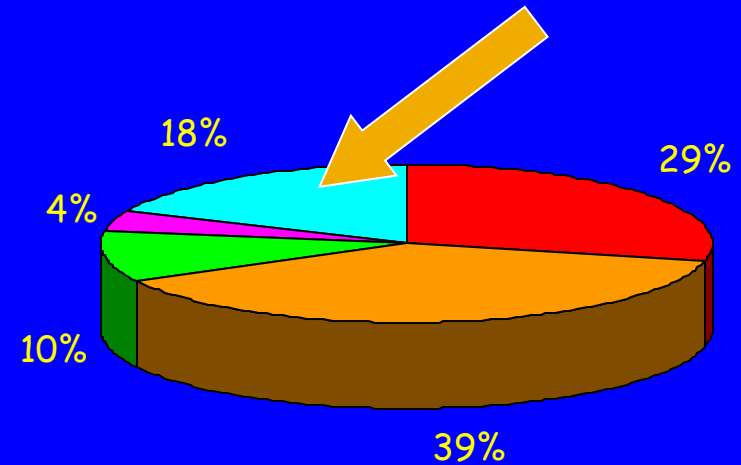

Significant results

- Bullying is a serious problem in both countries.
- Romanian kids are less threatened than Czech kids.
- They use the computer less than Czechs and their attitudes to it are slightly different.
- Among Czech kids there is a more open environment causing that attitudes to cyberbullying are less critical than between Romanian kids. Czech kids consider cyberbullying to be fun, they don't see possible impacts to the victim as drastically as Romanian kids do. Czechs see possible victims of school bullying also as a victim for cyberbullying.

Recommendation

- Signing of the charter is only a small step.
- Campaign against bullying must be permanent and all kids should know the possible ways of how to prevent it.
- Czech part should discuss more about the virtual world and Romanian part should firstly start a campaign against face to face bullying in Romanian schools.
